The Historic Skinner Cemetery from 1858

To visit Turn off US 377 heading south on Debbie Lane for about one third of a mile. You will find the cemetery is on the north side of the road canopied by giant oak trees.



Franklin College Bell

The original bell from Pilot Point Seminary School, which opened in 1872 as a primary and secondary school. The school started offering bachelor degrees in 1884 and officially changed its name to Franklin College in 1892. This was the earliest college in Denton County. The bell can be viewed at the Pilot Point Museum on the Historic Square.



Pilot Point's Little Free Library

The little free library is located on Jefferson Street, just south of Division (near the square). The books are free to borrow. Please feel free to donate books too!




The Bob Albrecht **WW1 Memorial**

Located in Historic Pilot Point Square on the Northwest side of the Gazebo.

Historic Stables, The Legends, formally known as McQuay Stables,

A Hall of Fame Stallion and a Ten Million Dollar Sire, Colonels Smoking Gun (Gunner), and legendary Hall of Fame Six Million Dollar Sire, Hollywood Dun It. Their resting site is visible from the highway.

Here you can find an antiquated gas pump where the total bill could not go over \$9.99. Interesting art prints can be found on the side of the building.
