TRY THESE FIVE WAYS TO PREPARE YOUR KIDS TO SEE SANTA

We have all seen the screaming and crying Santa photos. They really are adorable and there is nothing wrong with those photos, but maybe some try these tips before Santa could lessen the fear of this bigger than life jolly man. Here are five tips to try before and while seeing Santa this year:

Tip #1 - Read books about Santa. Let them see why this jolly man is so loved. Get them to know who Santa is before they even meet him in person. Just go online and look up books about Santa for kids. You will find a million titles to choose from.



Tip #2 - Write a wish list - if they are not old enough to write it on their own sit down with them and help them write one. If they have something in their hand to give to Santa it will act as a sort of security blanket.

Tip #3 - Watch a couple of Santa favorites together - This is a two for one idea. You get to introduce your kids to Santa AND have cozy family movie night. Grab a blanket, some popcorn and your favorite snacks and watch a beloved Santa movie. Some of our favorites are Miracle on 34th, Polar Express, Santa Clause is Coming to Town, The Santa Clause and many others.

Tip #4 - Watch what you say - You think you may be helping if you say "Santa is not scary" or "Don't be afraid of Santa, he's nice" but using those negative words when approaching Santa photos will only make them think that Santa IS in fact scary. Try using positive words when talking about Santa. Try using phrases like "Santa is so nice", "I like Santa!", or "I can't wait to meet Santa this year". If you are positive about Santa, your child won't even start with a fear of him.



Tip #5 - Don't stress or rush - Whether you are going to the mall or local photographer for Santa photos make sure you give yourself plenty of time to get your child dressed and ready for photos. They will sense you are stressed and become anxious. This should be a fun experience for everyone. Soak up every minute of your child's imagination and wonder when they meet Santa and all the magic that comes with him.

BONUSTIP - Try a local photographer who has Santa Mini sessions. Most of these sessions allow your child time to warm up to Santa and take their time. In our studio if a child is exceptionally scared of Santa, we tell Santa to step out of the room while the child sits in his chair. Then we have Santa stand behind them for a couple of fun happy photos. If the child is comfortable, we bring Santa back out and let him talk to the child to get candid unposed images for the family.



All three of my children have been afraid of Santa. Even my oldest who is 8 still needs time to warm up to him every year. Keep trying and eventually it gets easier. If not, you will always have the funny Santa memories to share and laugh about when they are older.
